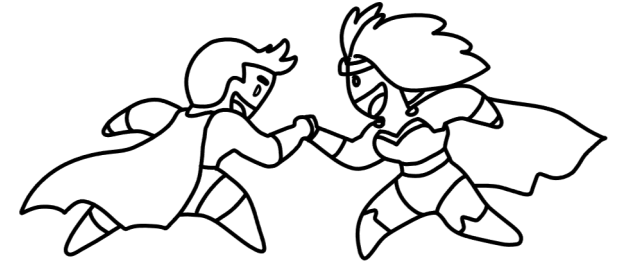


Activate your resources for climate protection

Instructions:

To save toner and the environment, we have kept the game minimal. Simply print out the following pages on Din A4 in black and white and cut out eight cards per page along the lines. Then put it on a pile and off you go!

Where do we draw strength from to work to protect the climate? For those who are desperate or depressed about climate change and feel paralyzed, this card collection is an invitation to start a conversation. Be it with others or with yourself.

Each card contains a question that encourages people to remember beautiful, positive, helpful and interesting things. The cards can be used in a group, in the family or as a couple to exchange ideas on the topic of climate change and its consequences, to get to know each other better and to motivate and inspire each other.

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How does it feel when you 'do something for the environment'. Describe a 'good deed for the climate' that you have been doing recently. How did that feel?

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If you think of the nature in your immediate living environment: is there a place that you find particularly beautiful and do not want to miss? Describe it!

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Who is your 'climate change buddy' who best motivates you to change something in your behavior for climate protection?

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Have you ever talked to a child about climate change? Describe the encounter or what you would like to talk to a child about.

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Which person has pleasantly surprised you lately when it comes to climate change?

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In the context of combating climate change: If you could give someone a special award, who would you give it to and for what?

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In which landscape do you feel most comfortable? And why?

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Name three terms that best describe your feelings about climate change.

What old hobby could you take up again to do something about climate change?

What supportive sentence would you say to someone who is very despondent and pessimistic about our 'climate future'?

In your opinion, what does 'generosity' mean when it comes to climate change and climate protection?

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How would you describe a forest to someone who has never been in one or has never seen one?

What do you admire about another person who does something for the climate that is inconceivable for you?

Name three characteristics or terms that you think could help us fight climate change.

For which innovation in the field of environmental protection are you particularly grateful in recent years?

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Who have you had a pleasantly positive chat with lately about climate change? What was good about your conversation?

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What kind of nature experience have you ever experienced that you wish many other people could experience?

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Name three people who you think would like to play this game, but who are not there right now. What would be their motivation to play along, what do you think?

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What is the most beautiful natural sound for you? And why?

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Who is your best advisor when it comes to protecting the climate? Who do you turn to?

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Do you have a tip on saving the climate for everyone that you want to share? In your opinion, what is a simple, big impact step that anyone can take?

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What sentence would you like others to say to you when you have a pessimistic day and think that the climate can no longer be saved?

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If you could write down your thoughts, fears and hopes about climate change, which form would you prefer: a poem, a novel, a non-fiction book, a song?

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What do you think is a great luxury for yourself today? Give three examples.

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What is completely normal for you in your consumption behavior today that was unthinkable for you a few years ago?
